DRYCLEANING REPORTING FORM

This form will satisfy the SAM reporting requirement for drycleaning operations. Drycleaning Operations should report the usage of all volatile organic compounds.

- This form should be completed in its entirety.
- For companies consuming products containing Volatile Organic Compounds, the simplest way to determine the usage, would be by the inventory method. The Beginning Inventory of quantities at the start of the year, plus quantities purchased during the calendar year, less the Ending Inventory of quantities at the end of the year. This result will yield the quantity of product used during the emission reporting year.
- List the annual quantities used, next to the appropriate category, making sure to state the units of measure if the quantity is not stated in gallons. If another VOC solvent was used, then please state the material and quantity used after "Other" at the bottom of the VOC column, or on a separate sheet of paper that is attached to this form.
- Be sure to properly identify your company and include your plant ID number, which can be found on the upper right corner of the company mailing label. This form must be authorized and signed by the appropriate Company Official.
