Temporary Lane Closures on the Gene Synder Freeway

The Department of Highways has announced temporary lane closures on KY 841 (Gene Synder Freeway) in Jefferson County between Dixie Highway and Interstate 65 (mile points 0 and 10.2). Lane closures are possible each evening as part of the installation of median cable barriers along this section of KY 841. These lane closures will occur in the evening from 7:00p.m. until 5:00 a.m. the following morning. This project is scheduled for completion in October 2009.
