Clearing and Cleaning Homes

Clearing homes of flood-damaged drywall, carpets and belongings is a **critical health concern**. Those items **must be removed** as soon as possible for the safety of your family.

Louisville Metro Government is working with Metro United Way and volunteers with Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster to clear, clean and disinfect homes for people who need help. If you have damage and need help, **please call 292-6115 TODAY**.

NO Citations or Fines for Curbside Debris

You may place flood-damaged property at curbside for removal. Louisville Metro Government **will not cite or fine residents** for placing flood-damaged property at curbside during our flood recovery effort.

Debris Removal from Curbside

Louisville Metro Solid Waste **crews are clearing flood-damaged property from curbsides** in the most heavily damaged areas as part of the city's on-going junk pick-up routes. The effort will take several weeks, but **flood-damaged debris will be removed free of charge** for those who cannot transport it to drop-off sites.

Louisville Metro Government crews and Metro United Way volunteers are making targeted collections of flood-damaged property outside the junk pick-up routes. To request pick-up of flood damaged property, call Metro United Way at 292-6115.
