Floyd Street from Central Avenue to Boxley Avenue

No on street parking will be permitted on Third Street from Heywood Avenue to Southern Parkway from 5:00 a.m. until Noon.

Metro Storm Debris Pickup Update

This is the latest update provided to me this week by the Director of Public Works...

“Each of the four pickup grids that lie inside your district has crews working in them. The northern half of Grid B-5 has been completed; the southern half of Grid B-6 is nearing completion; Grid B-7 is complete; and Grid D-3 will likely be totally complete this week. As of yesterday, both FEMA and our Unions have agreed to let us use contractors everywhere. As of today, the southern half of Grid B-5 and the southern half of Grid B-6 have been assigned to contractors. In the next week or so, Public Works crews will begin assisting the Parks Department with cleanup in the various Parks”

Debris Drop-off Sites Open This Saturday

Public Works crews will again open three locations for storm debris drop-off this Saturday

The three free sites will be open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, April 11. **They WILL NOT be open Sunday because of the Easter Holiday.**

- **Hubbards Lane Public Works Facility, 595 Hubbards Lane**
- **Meriwether Public Works Facility, 600 Meriwether Ave.**
- **Behind the Southwest Government Center, 7219 Dixie Highway (enter off St. Andrews Church Drive)**

The sites are open to private citizens only; no businesses or contractors. Residents may drop off tree debris only; building materials, such as shingles, fencing and siding, will not be accepted.
