

**Public Hearing Minutes
of the
Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control Board
May 20, 2009**

A public hearing of the Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control Board was called to order on May 20, 2009, at 10:04 a.m. in the Board Room of the Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control District (District), 850 Barret Avenue, Louisville, Kentucky, by the Chairman, Dr. Robert Powell.

General Statement, Rules and Purpose

The Chairman read the opening announcements, rules and purpose of the Public Hearing, which was to review proposed amendments to Regulation 2.05 *Prevention of Deterioration of Air Quality*, Version #9, Draft #3 – Proposed May 20, 2009.

1. Regulation 2.05 *Prevention of Deterioration of Air Quality*, Version #9, Draft #3 – Proposed May 20, 2009

Michelle Stites, Environmental Coordinator, reviewed the proposed amendments to Regulation 2.05 that were required in order to be consistent with the current EPA prevention of significant deterioration (PSD) regulation. Ms. Stites said the draft regulation incorporated the federal PSD regulation.

Ms. Stites said that during the public comment period, the District received comments from the Kentucky Division for Air Quality and EPA stating their approval of the changes.

Comments

Mr. Greg Long, representing the Ford Motor Company, expressed Ford's support of the proposed modifications to Regulation 2.05, which will allow the local Ford plants to remain flexible and competitive.

Ms. Emily Boone, representing the Clifton Community Council, stated the council encourages the Board to continue to enforce regulations to improve the community's air quality.
