Members of the public may request to be notified of regular or special meetings as provided for in KRS 61.820 and KRS 61.825. Records of the Louisville/Jefferson County Emergency Planning Committee, including the Jefferson County Emergency Response Plan, and chemical-inventory forms, or any follow-up emergency notices as may subsequently be issued, are open for inspection. Members of the public who wish to review these records may do so Monday through Friday, from 0800 to 1500 EST by appointment only at 7301 Logistics Drive, as required by the Kentucky Open Records Law. The local 24-hour telephone number for purpose of emergency notification as required by SARA is 9-1-1.
