

Westport Corridor Small Area Plan Advisory Group Meeting

Introduction

Ken Baker began the meeting by welcoming the advisory group and those from the community in attendance. Mr. Baker gave an overview of the agenda and then asked the group to introduce themselves.

1. Questionnaire Discussion

Steve Sizemore distributed the citizen survey to the advisory group and asked that they review and make any comments before it is distributed to the larger community. The survey along with the PARK Exercise will be important to capture the current issues in the area along with setting the groundwork to formulate a vision statement along with recommendations.

2. PARK Exercise

Mr. Baker explained the four components of the PARK exercise to the Advisory Group. Notepads were distributed to the group and they were asked to list items on their individual sheets and then place them on the larger boards under the appropriate component of PARK. Mr. Baker and Mr. Sizemore then reviewed each component and formulated common themes from the individual notes. The themes for each PARK component were then ranked through a dot exercise.
