The OFW recognizes both the strengths of the community as well as existing unmet needs.

The focus of the OFW is broad and includes issues that affect women's physical and mental health; social and economic well-being; employment; housing; political involvement; legal issues; and safety issues such as domestic violence and abuse, while working to ensure that services and activities are carried out in a culturally competent manner.

Issues and needs are assessed by on-going, extensive staff participation on various committees;

relationships with women's organizations; direct contact with the community; research activities; speaking engagements; and direct calls from community members.
