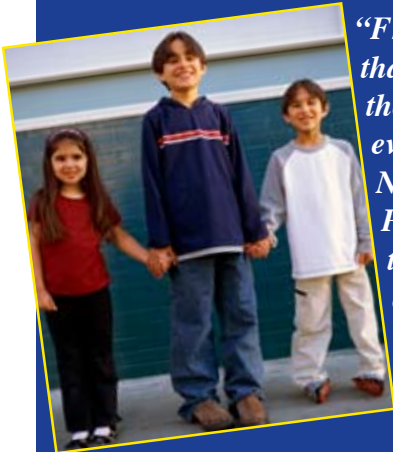

What Is Neighborhood Place?

Neighborhood Place is a partnership of public sector agencies that have come together to create a network of community-based “one-stop” service centers. The purpose is to provide blended and accessible health, education, employment and human services that support children and families in their progress toward self-sufficiency.

What Makes Neighborhood Place Unique?

- **A Community Focus**—The model provides quick and easy access to family services in a neighborhood setting supported by the work of an active Community Council.
- **A Team Approach**—Agencies collaboratively design strategies to enhance each other’s work and maximize resources for families.
- **Single Self-Assessment Process**—Families are encouraged to complete a self assessment form which allows them to access multiple services.
- **A Common Release Form**—A “Consent to Release Information” form allows agencies to share information and communicate about the goals of the family.

What Services are Available at Neighborhood Place?

Services offered at the Neighborhood Places reflect the needs of the community. They may include:

- Emergency Financial Assistance
 - Food Stamps/Medicaid
 - Women Infants Children Nutrition Program (WIC)
 - Substance Abuse Education / Prevention/Targeted Assessment
 - Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (KTAP/TANF)
 - School Social Services
 - Immunizations
 - Child Care Assistance
 - Child Protection
 - Healthy Start/HANDS
 - Family Intervention Services
 - Foster/Adoptive Parent Support
 - Linkages to employment
