

3.5.2 Implementation Through Existing Programs

The Local Capabilities Assessment Matrix and the Local Code Summary in Section 3.4.1 demonstrate the local planning mechanisms available for incorporating the requirements of the hazard mitigation plan. The assessments will be updated as needed, during the annual review and standard enforcement of the existing authorities, programs, and mitigation actions.

The Action Plan projects address reducing the effects of hazards on new buildings and infrastructure as well as existing buildings and infrastructure. Activities also incorporate mitigation activities into other planning mechanisms and recommends mitigation projects that can be integrated into job descriptions, comprehensive plans, capital improvement plans, zoning and building codes, site plans, permitting, and other planning tools, where appropriate. The Mayor and the Louisville Metro Council will incorporate the action plan as applicable with other plans as they are developed via directives or through legislative process.
