

**Minutes
Public Hearing
of the
Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control Board
May 17, 2006**

A public hearing of the Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control Board was called to order on May 17, 2006, at 10:04 a.m. in the Board Room of the Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control District, 850 Barret Avenue, Louisville, Kentucky, by the Chair, Dr. Karen Cassidy.

General Statement, Rules and Purpose

The Chair read the opening announcement, rules, and purpose of the Public Hearing, which was to review a proposed Agreed Board Order with Kosmos Cement Company.

Agreed Board Order with Kosmos Cement Company

Terri Phelps, Enforcement Supervisor, summarized the alleged violations of the Kosmos Cement Company of failing to take precautions on at least six occasions to prevent fugitive particulate emissions from becoming airborne at the 15301 Dixie Highway plant. Ms. Phelps reported that the company agrees to perform the required measures to control emissions established in 2003 and 2004. To fully resolve the alleged violations, Kosmos Cement Company has agreed to pay an administrative settlement of \$8,850 to the District.

Statements

No statement was made.

Barbara Sexton Smith asked if the violations occurred because the company failed to take actions to control fugitive particulate emissions. Ms. Phelps responded that on one occasion she observed a violation caused by the plant roads not being treated to suppress dust.
