

**Public Hearing Minutes
of the
Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control Board
October 21, 2009**

A public hearing of the Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control Board was called to order on October 21, 2009, at 10:05 a.m. in the Board Room of the Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control District, 850 Barret Avenue, Louisville, Kentucky, by the Chairman, Dr. Robert Powell.

General Statement, Rules and Purpose

The Chairman read the opening announcements, rules and purpose of the Public Hearing which was to review the draft proposed amendment to Regulation 2.08 *Fees*.

1. Draft proposed amendment to Regulation 2.08 *Fees*, Version 23, Draft 3, proposed October 21, 2009

Ms. Anderson said that the draft proposed amendment to Regulation 2.08 *Fees* was presented to the Board at the September 2009 Board meeting. She said that further discussion of Regulation 2.08 was tabled at the Board meeting due to a comment the District received at the Public Hearing from Ford Motor Company. Ford commented about the proposed fee for a permit that contains a Plantwide Applicability Limit (PAL), which is in Section 2.9 of the amended regulation. Ms. Anderson said the commenter did not object to the fee for the initial issuance of a PAL permit, but for the annual fee, which was the same amount as the initial issuance fee.

Ms. Anderson said the District re-examined the amount of work involved in overseeing the ten-year PAL permit after receiving Ford's comments. She said the District took Ford's comments into consideration and amended Regulation 2.08 *Fees*, and proposed that the annual fee for a PAL permit be established at \$2,000. She said that since the September 2009 Board meeting, additional administrative edits were made to Regulation 2.08 to improve readability.
