

**Minutes
Public Hearing
of the
Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control Board
June 21, 2006**

A public hearing of the Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control Board was called to order on June 21, 2006, at 10:04 a.m. in the Board Room of the Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control District, 850 Barret Avenue, Louisville, Kentucky, by the Chair, Dr. Karen Cassidy.

General Statement, Rules and Purpose

The Chair read the opening announcement, rules, and purpose of the Public Hearing, which was to review a proposed Agreed Board Order with Masonic Homes of Kentucky.

Agreed Board Order with Masonic Homes of Kentucky

Terri Phelps, Enforcement Supervisor, summarized the alleged violations of the Masonic Homes of Kentucky (Masonic Homes), which allowed workers not trained in asbestos abatement to remove a boiler covered with asbestos-containing material (ACM) from the boiler room of the facility located at 3701 Frankfort Avenue. In addition, Masonic Homes did not comply in a timely manner with a request from the District to immediately seal the building to prevent the release of asbestos fibers to the outside air. To fully resolve the alleged violations, Masonic Homes has paid an administrative settlement of \$13,000 to the District.
