

Keith Jackson is Supervisor of the Housing Division's Weatherization program. Keith is a licensed ordained minister, served as a pastor for seven years, and also worked as a loan officer and real estate agent for four years. He graduated from Eastern Kentucky University's Criminal Justice Program, and worked as a police officer for five years. In 2001, Keith began working for the Commonwealth of Kentucky where he monitored compliance of weatherization subgrantees, designed training on energy-efficient retrofit methods, and field-monitored weatherization activities. Keith has received training in a wide range of specialties including: troubleshooting and testing of gas and electric heating and water heating systems, various codes including the Fuel Gas Code, National Electric Code, Electrical Inspection Code and International Residential Code, blower-door efficiency diagnostics, thermal imaging, lead safe weatherization work practices and risk assessment, and energy-related mold and moisture issues. Keith came to the Housing Division in 2008.
